Please continue to be in prayer for each other. Encourage each other to pray about where the Lord would have them serve if they're not regular in church. We have so much they could be a part of.

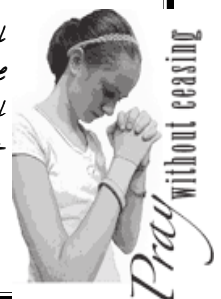

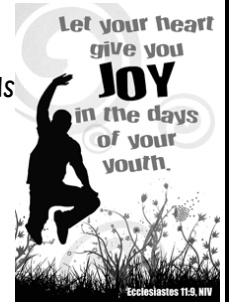
This weekend is our Annual Children's Summer Camp. It is going to be a great time of fun, fellowship

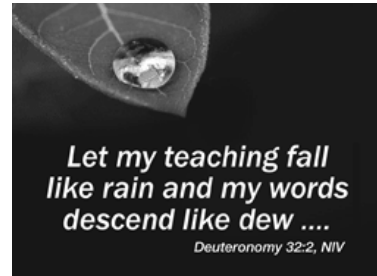
